The Main Campus Election Commission of the University Faculty Senate has verified the results of the Spring election of 2003. The ballot contained the names of seventeen (17) candidates, of whom ten (10) were elected.

A total of 613 ballots was distributed, of which 210 were received. Of the total 210 ballots received, 10 were not valid either because the envelopes lacked the required signature of the voter or were returned in unsealed envelopes. The 200 valid ballots represents approximately 33% of the faculty eligible to vote. Of the candidates elected, 5 are currently members of the Senate, 5 will become members.

Notification of the results of the election has been sent to all candidates.
